OUT-OF-SCHOOL-TIME (OST) PROGRAMS





Since 1995, Horizons National has worked closely with thirdparty evaluators and education data companies, including Yale University, Amplify, and Renaissance Learning, to assess the effectiveness of the program.

In a recent study of 5 years of school district data for Horizons students and their peers, Horizons students achieved:

- **Consistent gains** of 6-10 weeks of grade equivalence in reading and math over summer sessions
- Higher attendance rates
- Lower chronic absenteeism rates
- Higher scores on standardized assessments of elementary math and science
- Higher GPAs in 9th grade
- More course credit earned in 9th and 10th grade
- Fewer incidents of repeating a grade
- Fewer disciplinary referrals
